Long Service Awards

Purpose – To recognize Paramedic Association of New Brunswick members for their years of service in Emergency Medical Services providing patient care.

Award – The award will be in the form of:

- for 10 and 20 years of service, a Certificate and Pin
- for 25 years of service, a shadow box with New Brunswick Paramedic badge with recipients ID Number and engraved plaque
- for 30 years of service, a watch with the PANB logo and Star of Life embossed on the dial and recipient name and years engraved on back
- for 35 years of service, choice of one gift from a selection chosen annually, to a value of \$200, with appropriate engraving
- for 40 years of service, choice of one gift from a selection chosen annually, to a value of \$300, with appropriate engraving
- for 45 years of service, choice of one gift from a selection chosen annually, to a value of \$400, with appropriate engraving
- for 50 years of service, choice of one gift from a selection chosen annually, to a value of \$500, with appropriate engraving

Reason for Recognition – Required years of Active Service in Emergency Medical Services as a Patient Care Provider, emergency or non-emergency, in any jurisdiction and current membership in the Paramedic Association of New Brunswick.

Recipient Selection – The PANB Honours and Awards Committee will review all registrations and information submitted in the Annual Registration Renewal process. Based on the information submitted, and if required, follow-up clarification, the recipient list of those who have completed the required number of years will be compiled by the committee and submitted to the PANB Board of Directors for approval.

Award Presentation – The 10 and 20 Year Long Service Awards will be presented at a Chapter meeting. Long service Awards for 25 years and greater will be presented at the Annual PANB Awards Gala. For those unable to attend the Gala, the award will be presented at a Chapter meeting, at work, or delivered by mail.

Award Review – The Long Service Recognition will be reviewed annually by the PANB Honours and Awards Committee. Recommended changes will be submitted to the PANB Board of Directors for approval.
