Recognition of Contribution to Paramedicine

Purpose – To recognize Paramedic Association of New Brunswick current or past members in good standing and with no regulatory disciplinary action, for their activities that promote awareness of and that further the development of the Paramedic profession or any person, as deemed appropriate by the Honours and Awards Committee and the Board of Directors, making a significant contribution to Paramedicine in New Brunswick.

Award – The award will be in the form of an etched glass trophy that displays the purpose of the award, the Star of Life, the name the recipient and date.

Considerations – When making submissions for the recognition, factors to be considered are:

Educational – Mentoring, Preceptor, EMS/First-Aid Instructor, etc.

Research – Conducting EMS Research Programs, Participating in EMS Research, Using research for Program/Procedure development, etc.

Association – Committee Activity

Intra-professional – Participation in Events, Education, or Development with other professional groups i.e. MFR, RN, MD, Police, Fire, EMO, etc.

Volunteer for EMS Public Event Participation – Displays, Parades, Fairs, etc.

It is not required that all considerations are met for recognition.

Nominations – Nominations for the recognition are open to all PANB members. Nominations may be submitted by any member of PANB or the public and must include: the nominator's name and contact information, the nominee's name, address, PANB ID number (if available) and the activities that support the nomination. The nomination can be made at any time. Nominations received by May 31st of the current year will be considered for presentation at the Annual PANB Awards Dinner held in October of the current year.

Recipient Selection – The PANB Honours and Awards Committee will review all nominations received from June 1 to May 31. Based on the information submitted, and if required, follow-up clarification, a recipient list will be compiled and submitted to the PANB Board of Directors for approval. Nominees not selected can be resubmitted for consideration in subsequent years.

Award Review – The Contribution to Paramedicine Recognition will be reviewed annually by the PANB Honours and Awards Committee. Recommended changes will be submitted to the PANB Board of Directors for approval.
